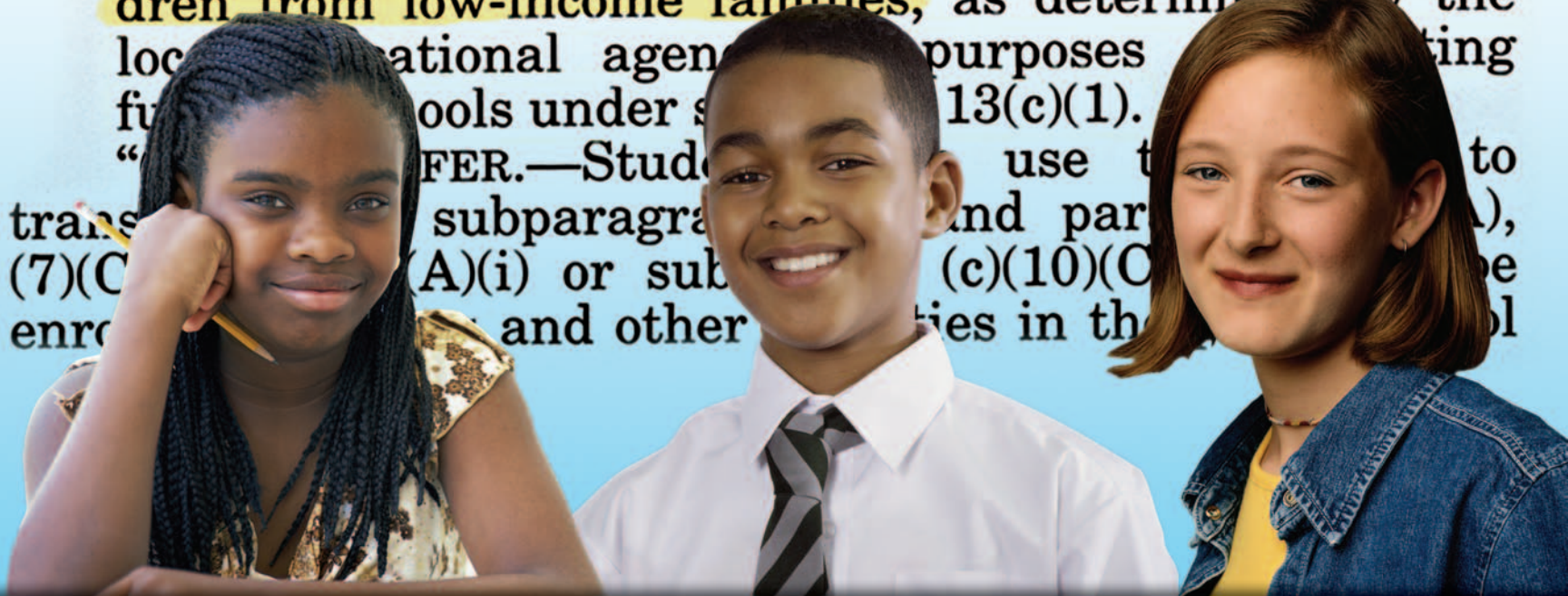


As the Albany district's new Kelton Court Middle School opens this fall, be sure you know your rights.

(ii) RULE.—In providing students the option to transfer to another public school, the local educational agency shall give priority to the lowest achieving children from low-income families, as determined by the local educational agency for purposes of determining funding for schools under section 113(c)(1).
“...FER.—Students use the option to transfer to another public school under paragraph (A), (7)(C)(A)(i) or subparagraph (c)(10)(C) to be enrolled in a better school and other facilities in the school district.”



Under federal law, students attending Hackett and Livingston have the right to transfer to a better public school.
